What's happening?

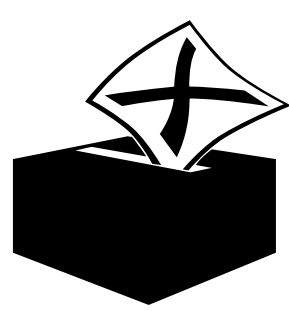
