1	Student Groups Grant Introductio n	 IL: let's get going. I would advise you keep the applications up from last year alongside looking at this current round of applications to make comparisons. It may also be worth us agreeing a standard amount for campus league. There is £20,000 available to allocate but groups have requested £95,000 in funding. It may also be good for us to agree an amount for food-but there are variables for events within this still JW: for food it is tricky to put a number on I think IL: we don't have as much funds to work with this time though which I think is important to bear in mind. We have about 2 minutes available per application to work through. For food I would suggest not agreeing more than £100 per time money is allocated JW: with for further information requests as well, I think flat out refusal for requests where there is very limited information provided sounds sensible too MW: I agree with this NC: I agree that for lack of effort/information provided we say no to these requests. Where 	



we want extra information though we should give these groups a chance to respond

- IL: funding for balls is a no. Are we happy to accept requests for retrospective grants? We need to make sure we double check these against last years' grants
- XB: it is important to know if money is for the student claiming back or for the group for retrospective requests
