The role also promotes positive relationships between students and the service of the Hall Reps Scheme.

We are looking for candidates who have experience of successfully delivering projects or events within budget along with experience of delivering training and the ability to participate in developing productive working relationships with stakeholders.

This role will involve working some evenings and weekends as appropriate, to ensure effective engagement with the Hall Reps Scheme.
